



Ulla Viotti

Ulla Viotti studied at the School of Art, Blackpool, United Kingdom and Konstfack, University College of Arts, Crafts and Design, Stockholm between 1950 and 1956.

She has been invited to countless international symposia worldwide and is represented in museums and sculpture parks globally.

Since 1969 Viotti has created around 80 permanent sculptural, architectural installations for public environments such as the Swedish Parliament Library Stockholm, where she created a stone floor. Viotti has also run workshops at universities in the USA and at the Banff Centre for the Arts, Canada.

Viotti organised the first International Ceramic Symposium in Sweden in 1975 and the first Grass Sculpture Exhibition in Hammenhög, Sweden in 1996.

Since 1990 she has been working periodically at Petersen Tegl and is a founder member of WABA.

Viotti has been elected member of the International Academy of Ceramics since 1971 and an Honorary Member of the Swedish Sculpture Society since 1996.
